Commissioned by the DCSF to support the progressive implementation of key policies and initiatives including *Removing Barriers to Achievement*, the Government's strategy for Special Educational Needs.

## Working with the Transition Support Programme



- Small team of regional advisers working as part of the national transition support team
- Working in partnership with Local Areas to support the development of transition practice and particularly to help to move practice on from minimum standards
- Support SEN Regional Hubs to provide networked support between Local Areas

## SEN Regional Hubs and the Transition Support Programme



- 1) Run development groups to disseminate and apply key national and regional initiatives, and to feed back on and contribute to the development of national initiatives.
- 2) Each regional hub will establish a TSP strand leader who will coordinate the hub's support for the TSP, principally planning and coordinating LA networking designed to promote the development of best practice in transition support.

## SEN Regional Hubs and the Transition Support Programme



The regional hub's role will include:

- Liaison with the NS TSP regional adviser, CSIP adviser and the NTST
- Planning, facilitating and reviewing the effectiveness of networking activity across the region
- Acting as a broker of support available from the menu of support from NTST to the networks
